ABOUT THE WORLD ANTIBIOTIC AWARENESS WEEK EUROPEAN ANTIBIOTIC AWARENESS DAY

European Antibiotic Awareness Day (EAAD), created by the European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control (ECDC), is marked on Monday 18 November 2019, in partnership with WHO's World Antibiotic Awareness Week (18 – 24 November 2019).

The objective is to increase awareness of global antibiotic resistance and encouraging best practices among the general public, healthcare professionals and policy makers to avoid the further emergence and spread of antibiotic resistance.

World Antibiotic Awareness Week / European antibiotic awareness day 2018

This year's World Antibiotic Awareness Week's theme is "keep antibiotics working". The theme explores the role of healthcare workers in reducing antibiotic resistance in hospitals and other healthcare settings through infection prevention and control measures.

Moreover, this year the European antibiotic awareness day (18 November) coincides with the launch of the results of the ECDC wide survey of healthcare workers knowledge and attitudes about antibiotic use and resistance.

On World Antibiotic Awareness Week (18 to 24 November), EAHP encourages hospital pharmacist to make direct interventions within multidisciplinary care teams such as reviewing antibiotic duration, advising on the cessation of inappropriate antibiotic treatments, and educating other healthcare professionals on the restricted use of certain antibiotics.






