The 18th Congress of the European Association of Hospital Pharmacists (EAHP), to be held in Paris in one week's time, will place a unique spotlight on issues of inter-professional collaboration through its theme: "Improving patient outcomes: a shared responsibility".

The 2013 congress will see the introduction of the Synergy satellite programme, run alongside the packed programme of speakers, workshops and seminars investigating hospital pharmacy operational, conceptual and therapeutic matters.
