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At the end of the one hour presentation and one and a half hour workshop participants will understand the need for personal qualities in leadership. They will demonstrate *Learning Outcomes (in italic)* under four headings for this topic.

- a) Planning
- b) Managing resources
- c) Managing people
- d) Managing performance

a) Planning

Participants will show that they can:

- support plans for services that are part of the strategy for the wider healthcare system; gather feedback from patients, service users and colleagues to help develop plans;

- contribute their expertise to planning processes;

- appraise options in terms of benefits and risks.

b) Managing resources

Participants will demonstrate that they can:

- accurately identify the appropriate type and level of resources required to deliver safe and effective services;

- ensure services are delivered within allocated resources;

- minimise waste;

- take action when resources are not being used efficiently and effectively.

c) Managing people

Participants will demonstrate that they appreciate the need to:

provide guidance and direction for others using the skills of team members effectively;
review the performance of the team members to ensure that planned service outcomes are met;

- support team members to develop their roles and responsibilities;

- support others to provide good patient care and better services.

d) Managing performance

Participants will demonstrate that they can:

- analyse information from a range of sources about performance;
- take action to improve performance;
- take responsibility for tackling difficult issues;
- build learning from experience into future plans.
