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The poster exhibition and the oral poster communication session are the mainstay of the annual European Association of Hospital Pharmacists (EAHP) Congress and only the best are selected!

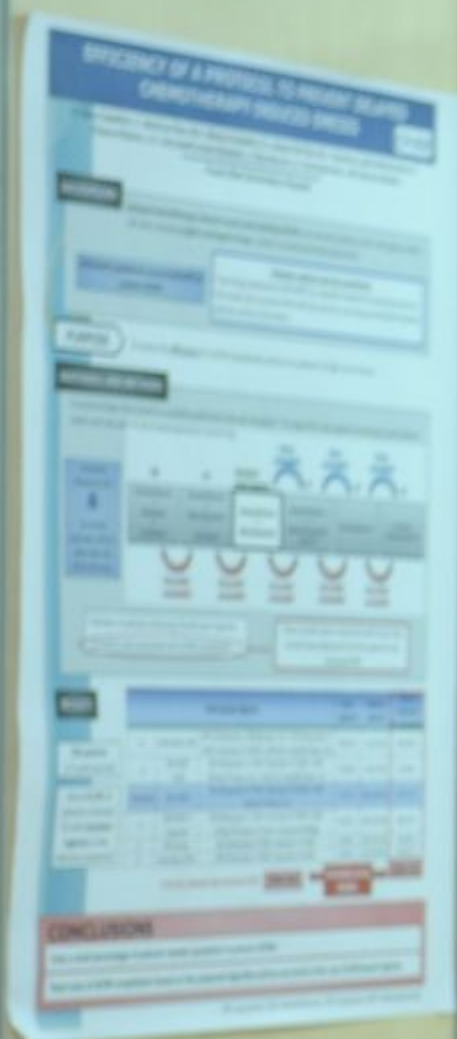
