The European Association of Hospital Pharmacists sends its warmest congratulations to <u>Professor Lee Vermeulen</u> [1] on being awarded the prestigious <u>Donald E. Franke Medal</u> [2] for his contributions to international pharmacy practice.

The American Society of Health System Pharmacists [3] (ASHP) present the accolade each year as recognition to those pharmacists who drive improvement of pharmacy practice across international borders.

In addition to playing an inspiring role in the creation of <u>FIP's 2008 Basel Statements</u> [4] on international hospital pharmacy practice, Prof Vermeulen was a lynchpin of good advice and event facilitation when EAHP and its members created the subsequent <u>European Statements</u> of Hospital Pharmacy [5] in May 2014.
