VIENNA

Vienna has gained International glory thanks to its monumental buildings - among whose the Schönbrunn Palace, the Hofburg Imperial Palac

- as well as thanks its rich musical and art tradition, which

evokes the names of Mozart, Beethoven, Schubert, Strauss, Klimt, Schiele.

The city of Vienna is also linked to the ancient history of the Asburgic dynasty and the legendary Princess Sissi, to the elegance of its famous cafes, to the romantics of Strauss' Blue Danube, to the green Prater amusement park dominated by its giant ferries wheel, to the exhibitions of the white Lippizan stallions up to the modern buildings and skyscrapers of the UNO-City, headquarters of United Nations and other International institutions offices.

Public Transportation -

Transportation to and from the Vienna airport

Vienna International Airport, <u>www.viennaairport.com</u>, is located ca. 18 km (11 miles) south-east of the Austrian capital near to the town of Schwechat.

Train (S-Bahn)

Located underneath terminal, one level below arrivals - www.oebb.at

Hours: 5:00-24:00.

The S-Bahn S7 and the less-frequent S2 and RSB7 go to Wien-Mitte, as well as stopping at other metro stations with direct connection to every subway line in the city and numerous trams and trains. It takes between 18 and 27 minutes to reach Wien-Mitte.

Fare: € 3.60 one way.

Vienna Airport line busses

Located outside arrivals - http://www.postbus.at/en/

Hours: 5:00-24:00.

Direct buses drive frequently between Vienna International Airport and various points in Vienna. Tickets can be purchased with cash from the operator.

Fare: One way: € 6, Round-trip: € 11.

- Morzinplatz/Schwedenplatz line goes to the city center (District 1). Buses every 30 minutes, the trip takes 20 minutes. At Schwedenplatz there is a connection to the underground lines U1 and U4 as well as buses and trams.
- Meidling/Westbahnhof line is the railway connector, departing every 20-30 minutes and stopping at Miedling Railway Station(30 min.) and Westbahnhof/West Railway Station(45 min.).
- Kaisermühlen VIC/Kagran line goes to Vienna International Center/the UN and serves hotels in the eastern part of Vienna. Runs hourly and takes 20-45 min, depending upon destination.

City Airport Train (CAT)

Located underneath terminal, one level below arrivals - www.cityairporttrain.com

Non-stop to Wien-Mitte Station (Landstraße) in 16 minutes.

Departs at :05 and :35 past the every hour.

The return departs Wien-Mitte at :08 and :38 past the hour.

Fare: one way €10, return trip € 18.

Taxi

Approximate cost is from € 25 to € 30.
