- Monday to Sunday from 6:00 am to 7:00 pm, except in special cases.				
→ <u>Exhibitions</u> :				
For delivery hours, please refer to technical guide / exhibitors manual.				
When arriving at the site, drivers must:				
 Stop behind the barrier at the gatehouse. Present the signed safety protocol. 				
3) Go to the indicated loading/unloading point (green, yellow, blue, or black hall).				
4) Take note of the nearest emergency exit, fire extinguisher and telephone.5) Follow the instructions of the site manager.				
6) Follow instructions for the post-loading/unloading return trip.				
Instructions for loading and unloading :				
 After receiving authorization to park at the loading dock, drivers must: 				
1) Open the vehicle's doors.				
2) Position the vehicle in the bay indicated by the loading dock personnel.3) Turn off their engine and apply brakes.				
4) For trailers with air suspension: lock the suspension.

Safety instructions for the loading/unloading operation :				
 The driver has read the general safety instructions given in Appendix 3 and is responsible for following them. 				
To assist with loading/unloading the vehicle, the driver must :				
1) Wear foot protection.				
2) Use the designated walkways.3) Stay within the safety area.				
4) Use his or her own unloading equipment or the equipment of the supplier company.				
Finally, the driver is responsible for securing the merchandise.




DELIVERY AREA ACCESS MAP


DELIVERY AREA TRAFFIC PLAN

Please respect safety guidelines in the Palais des Congrès de Paris' loading areas.

A cautious, responsible approach

LE PALAIS DES CONGRÈS DE PARIS

Short-stay parking is only authorized in the delivery area during loading/unloading operations.

Overnight parking is not permitted.

The MC1.2.8 and 9 freight lifts may only be operated by lift operators

DELIVERY AREA SAFETY A TOP PRIORITY

Welcome to the Palais des Congrès de Paris delivery area

To avoid any risk to your safety, it is important that you follow the safety guidelines closely when operating in the loading area.

Loading area hours of operation

- Monday to Sunday from 6 am to 7 pm (with exceptions)

Access control at entrance to the loading area

- Report to the warden's office
- Present your delivery documents
- Respect the delivery guidelines provided by on-duty staff

- Restricted pedestrian access -

Vehicles not permitted in the loading area: LPG and hazardous goods vehicles.

Driving guidelines for vehicles

- Switch on your headlights
- Drive at 15 km/h maximum authorized speed
- Respect the traffic flow obey signs
- Head for the hall indicated colour-coded (yellow blue black green)

- Respect pedestrian rights of way

Parking guidelines for vehicles

- Park correctly use the parking spaces provided
- Switch off your engine once in the loading bay

Parking time is strictly limited to the duration of loading/unloading operations

Guidelines for pedestrians

- Use only the designated walkways follow floor markings
- Remain alert to activities around you

Safety during loading/unloading operations

- Wear safety shoes
- and handling gloves
- Respect correct lifting and carrying techniques
- Do not operate lifting equipment without authorization
- When operating moving equipment, activate the warning light and siren
- Loading/unloading operations take priority over other traffic, so ensure that you keep a safe distance
- Beware of falling objects, bumps or collisions when operating equipment
- Respect the entry and exit signs in freight lifts

Orderliness and cleanliness - environment

- Sort waste materials (cardboard/paper; waste materials; foodstuffs)
- Unload goods in an orderly fashion do not block emergency exits or traffic lanes
- Leave loading areas and equipment in an orderly state

Evacuation procedure

- Leave the premises calmly
- Do not use elevators or freight lifts
- Never return to the site without authorization
- Assemble at the meeting point

Security

- The entire unloading area is under video surveillance
- Teams from the Palais des Congrès have authority in the loading area
- Controls have been increased in line with VIGIPIRATE (anti-terrorism measures)



Recap of unacceptable behaviour Parking not connected with loading/unloading operations Carrying or consuming drugs or alcohol Smoking within the loading area

Responsibility

If you fail to observe any of the above instructions, you may be denied future access to the loading area. If a vehicle is not correctly parked, it will be immobilized.
