

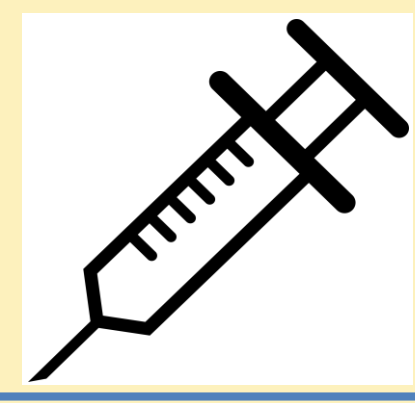
ISG12181 - Creation of an 'Agrippal' programme to fight against nosocomial flu

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What was done ?

- Creation of a programme to fight against nosocomial flu by our Healthcare-Associated Infectious Risk Prevention Unit in Winter 2018.
- Role : Promote vaccination inside and outside the hospital.



Why was it done ?

- Strengthen anti-influenza herd immunity
 - Reduce the risk of nosocomial influenza
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- Improve vaccination rate of staff and inhabitants of the institution's living area

Improve knowledge about vaccination

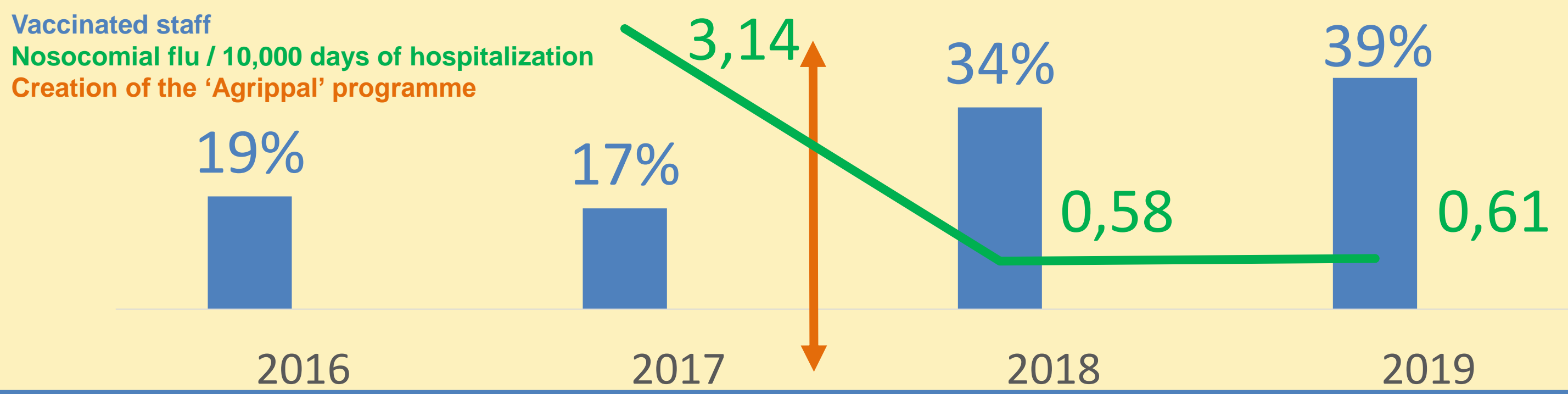


How was it done ?

- Information conferences in the hospital and in the city.
- Information material in all departments.
- National Health reimbursement forms in key departments.
- Creation of a Mobile Vaccination Team to vaccinate staff in departments.
