What was done?

- Creation of a programme to fight against nosocomial flu by our Healthcare-Associated Infectious Risk Prevention Unit in Winter 2018.
- Role: Promote vaccination inside and outside the hospital.

Why was it done?

- Strengthen anti-influenza herd immunity
- Reduce the risk of nosocomial influenza

Lack of traceability of staff's flu vaccination




Improve vaccination rate of staff and inhabitants of the institution's living area

Improve knowledge about vaccination



How was it done?

- Information conferences in the hospital and in the city.
- Information material in all departments.
- National Health reimbursement forms in key departments.
- Creation of a Mobile Vaccination Team to vaccinate staff in departments.

- Rate of vaccinated staff doubled.
- Reduction of the risk of nosocomial flu for patients.
